Accounts

The Treasurer noted that only draft accounts for the period 01/02/22 to 31/01/23 were made available to members and interested parties prior to the AGM. In preparing the accounts for the CIO it became apparent that the Old Village Hall had incorrectly allocated £90,020 as a disposal. The Old Village Hall charity has now been merged with the CIO to allow a prior year adjustment to be made in the financial year ending 31/01/23. Finalised accounts are now to be agreed by the Independent Examiner as soon as possible.
